PRESIDENT'S REPORT



Yet more Covid-19 restrictions affected us this year, but our membership grew once more regardless and there remained some stellar results and achievements all around.

In competition, we sent two Olympians to Tokyo; won two Athletics NSW (ANSW) awards and four national medals; we celebrated 15 State Champions, either as individuals or in a team; we bettered four Club records; we increased attendance at our Club event and again hosted the State 5k Championships.

Off the track, we safe-guarded our website, answered a plea from Bunnings to restart their BBQs post-pandemic and welcomed a new benefactor.

Tokyo Olympics

We congratulate both of our Olympians, Morgan McDonald and Steve Solomon, for making it to the biggest stage in athletics. They both narrowly missed their finals: Morgan went within a second or so of the 5000m final and Steve finished third in his semi-final after easily winning his heat in a personal best time.

We must thank our benefactor, the late great Ken Goldman, for contributing to the financial assistance granted these athletes for the event.

Achievements by our Members in National Competition

The following members earned medals at the National Championships:

- Laura Roderick – Gold – U20 5000m Australian Junior T&F
- Nicholas Rodgers – Gold, Bronze – U18 800m, 1500m Australian Junior T&F
- Milly Boughton – Gold - U17 5000m Walk Australian Junior T&F Championship
- Piper Simpson – Gold, Silver – U15 3000m, 1500m Australian Junior T&F

A special mention goes to Bailey Habler for finishing second in the prestigious Zatopek U20 3000m.



A big thank you to those volunteers who assisted with the Australian Track Championships, which were held in Sydney for the second year in a row.

Achievements by our Members in State Competition

The following members earned gold medals at state events during this pandemic-reduced year:

- U16 Male team – NSW Cross Country relays
- U18 Male team – NSW Cross Country relays.

Overall at the NSW Cross Country relays, we fielded 12 junior teams for nine medals!

Also of note is that five of our athletes were selected for ANSW Targeted Talent program and we also provided instructors during the program's delivery.

Another amazing effort saw our Club earn 19 medals at the NSW Junior Track Championships. The following members won gold:

At the ANSW Track Relay Championships, we were represented by 26 teams, the largest representation in recent memory. The teams earned 14 medals in all, with the following earning gold:

- Open Women's 4x1500m
- Open Women's 4x800m
- Open Men's 4x1500m
- U18 Women's 4x1500m
- U18 Men's A 4x1500m.



Congratulations also go to Milly Boughton, winner of NSW Open Walker of the year, and Drew Fryer, winner of NSW Young Coach of the Year.

In a Club first, due to Covid-19, we conducted the first ever AGM-via-video-link in the history of the Club. TREASURER'S REPORT

As at 31 March 2022



For the financial year ended March 2022 the club made a loss of \$3,750. There was a significant uptick in expenditure with a total of \$12,304 for expenses. This compares with \$2,953 for FY2020-21. This is not unsurprising as we saw a return to competition and hence an increase in expenses such as state relays (\$2,248), Athlete assistance (\$1,500) and club sponsored athletes (\$1,895). If we go back to FY 2019-20, which is a more comparable year in terms of level of activity, we see expenses were \$9,972. Around \$2000 less than this reporting year. I think the club should aim to keep expenditure around the \$10,000 level for long term sustainability. On the revenue side we brought in \$8,452. This was largely composed of uniform sales, the BBQ fundraiser and an event hosting payment for the 5000m championships. The BBQ fundraised earned us a profit of \$1,152 and continues to be one of our best sources of fundraising. Special thanks to everyone who volunteered. We have net assets of \$40,552 as at 31st March 2022. The bulk of this is the \$27,434 cash in our Savings Account. This balance is slowly eroding and we should look to increase fundraising activity to ensure a sustainable future for the club. On a side note, please be aware that there was an amendment made to last year's financial reports as the profit from uniform sales was significantly overstated. FY 2020-21 overall profit was \$1,155 not \$2,775 as originally reported. A corrected copy of last year's reports has been attached at the end of this report.

TRACK AND FIELD REPORT



This season was another bumpy one with few major competitions cancelled due to Covid but also became an Olympic season due to circumstances. Beginning of winter season was practically cancelled with cross country and road relays not being held. The state and national cross-country championships were cancelled, same happened to State Road Relays.

The early results indicated that this could be very successful season for our club, we had good participation starting with NSW 3000m Championships featuring 46 RBH runners and continuing throughout the summer.

At NSW Track and Field Relays our club improved on the last season medal tally with 14 medals won (5 gold, 5 silver and 4 bronze), last season we won only 9 medals (2 gold, 3 silver and 4 bronze). The improvement was also achieved at NSW Junior and Open Championships.

At NSW Junior Championships we won 19 medals which is 4 more than last season.
