PRESIDENT'S REPORT



Another proud year for the Club saw nine of our members either compete internationally or qualify to do so, two members were National Champions, two other members received Athletics NSW (ANSW) awards, three Club records were broken - which is a good effort considering we have been around for over 100 years, we dominated the Open category in ANSW cross country and six of our members were State Champions.

Off the track, we found four new ways to promote the Club to the public, hosted a successful ANSW event and preserved Club history dating back to 1907.

Achievements in International Competition

- Selma Kajan competed in the 800m in Rio at her first Olympic Games. Her qualification was made all the more remarkable as she did so with only two weeks before the cut-off and she subsequently received our coveted Outstanding Achievement Award. Although Selma was ill during the Games and didn't run at her best, we are certain this won't be her last Olympics.
- Of the 24 Australians who qualified for the World Cross Country Championships this year, one-sixth of them hailed from our Club! Lexie Gilmour competed (80th) in the Open Women's event and Zac Facioni (65th) and Georgia Evans (67th) both competed in the Juniors. Emily Hopper also qualified but unfortunately suffered an injury leading up to the Championships. Thank you to the Doncaster Hotel for providing a nice venue to recognise these athletes at our farewell function for the Championships.
- Molly Blakey and Amy Harding-Delooze competed in the World Junior Championships, Molly in the 400m (7th/Heat 5) and Amy in the 1500m (11th/Heat 2).
- In the World Masters Championships, Anna Fitzgerald and Gary Howard both earned medals. Anna won gold in the W35 5k and 10k events, and Gary earned silver in the M40 800m.

Special mentions regarding Olympic qualification must go to Steve Solomon and Jeff Hunt. In the 400m, Steve missed out by just 0.04 of a second. Jeff ran a marathon qualification time of 2hrs:16mins but sadly was not in the first three selected for the Games.



Achievements in National Competition

Our three National Champions were Steve Solomon in the Open 400m, Lora Storey in the Open 800m and Zac Facioni in the U18 Cross Country Championships.

Club Records

- Morgan McDonald broke the Club's 5k Senior record with 13:29.79 at an American College meet. It should also be noted that he ran 7:51.19 over there in a 3k event. This would also be a Club Senior record if he hadn't been running indoors!
- Kate Spencer's 5000m 15:28.47 was close to an Olympic Qualifier and bettered our existing Club Senior record.
- Katelyn Simpson broke the Senior 1500m record in running 4:11.82.

Achievements in State Competition

Our domination of the State Cross Country events had to be seen to be believed. Thanks to Harry Summers and Kate Spencer, we won gold in the open men and women at both the Short Course and Long Course Championships.

In addition, at the Short Course our Open Women finished 4 out of the top 5 - Lexy Gilmour finished second, Lauren McKillop third in a huge comeback and Audrey a close finishing fifth.

We finished in high standings at the sharp end of the Winter Premiership, with our Open Men finishing 2nd, our Open Women in 3rd and our U/20 Women placing 2nd.

On the track, we had another four State Champions. Matt Hudson won the Open 5k and we had three 800m Champions: Lora Storey Opens – Lora's effort was no mean feat given that she had recently stepped up from the 400m hurdles; Amy Harding-Delooze in the U20's and Bailey Hubler in the U14's.

On a final note regarding state competition, our Open Men's team extended our streak of winning the State Road Relays for the 11th consecutive year and I can see no reason why this won't continue next year.

ANSW Awards

Kate Spencer was named Female Cross Country Athlete of the Year and Amy Harding-Delooze was named Junior Female Middle Distance Athlete of the Year.



City to Surf

Harry Summers had been trying to win this prestigious race for many years, and finally did so in emphatic fashion. I have been watching this race for many years and I can't recall anyone destroying the field up the first climb and going on to win. A nice aside to this victory was Harry thanking his Coach by giving him the wrist-watch awarded for first prize.

ANSW Event at ES Marks

The Club provided 14 volunteers to help ANSW host an interclub meet at our local field, ES Marks. This was nearly three times as many volunteers as we provided at the previous such event. Not only was there a notable improvement in the camaraderie of those volunteering, it earned the Club over \$700 after sharing the proceeds of the event with ANSW. In future, the Club plans to host one ANSW event annually.

Club Promotion

The Committee agreed this year to replace our existing marquee with one double the size. We predict that a larger marquee will attract more members, and we have incorporated our website address and social network accounts in the marquee's design in order to better engage with the public. The company which designed the marquee, Betta Marquees, also digitised the club logo which we can now use to improve the graphics on our uniforms and merchandise.

This year, we received a number of glowing testimonials that are now located on our website. We plan to also conduct some oral history interviews of our Life Members to supplement these testimonials to further promote the Club. We recently learned that many of our members are users of Instagram and have now opened an account with this network.

Club History

A transcript of the Club's original minute book, dating 1907-1909, was transcribed in its entirety for our website. Members can now look back in time, discover our origins and re-live the workings of our first ever Committee.

To conclude, I would like to thank you all for bringing me such joy every week that I'm out there training and competing. We have all signed up for a tough sport. However, I can assure you that the positivity in seeing you all smile despite the hard work and all the fine people I've met in this Club far outweighs the pain!

REGISTRAR'S REPORT



Following some wholesale changes by ANSW we have a huge increase in reported registration numbers for this year. ANSW have associated a large number of Little Athletes with our club. We now have 135 Dual LAANSW athletes. We may never see any of these athletes & they may never run with the senior club but obviously we hope as they continue in athletics that they stay with the club.

Athletics NSW has continued to franchise more clubs from schools and colleges. Unfortunately some of these clubs have been able to entice some talented athletes away from RBH. We hope that these athletes will remember the support that they received at our club and may return in the future.

ANSW have now been able to offer very tangible benefits in their new Run NSW Membership which is the equivalent of the old Winter memberships. While including eligibility to enter all 'traditional' Athletics NSW and Athletics Australia over the winter season this now offers free entry into 12 RunNSW events and a free RunNSW/Greater Running Shirt for competitors in the Sydney10. This has given us a larger Winter numbers than we have had in earlier years.

The female to male athlete ratio continues to increase. This year we have higher 105 females to 122 males (2016 we had 44 females and 63 males). TREASURER'S REPORT As at 31 March 2017



Following loss of **\$2,215** in the year to 31 March 2016, the Club returned another loss in **FY2017 of \$3,953**, reducing our net assets to \$45,578.

Our largest cost this year was Club funded registration fees for athletes meeting performance criteria set by the committee. As a result the Club paid \$3,210 of registration fees on behalf of its high performing athletes.

On the revenue side, we were pleased the Doncaster Hotel continued to offer a \$1000 financial sponsorship. The club held all club functions and all committee meetings at the Doncaster Hotel. We hope this relationship continues. Further, the Club successfully hosted and provided volunteers to Round 4 of the Treloar Shield at ES Marks. The profits from the day were split 50:50 between RBH and ASNW. Our share was \$758.

The Club continues to generate enough revenue to cover the cost of ANSW affiliation fees and team entries at all State Relay competitions.

TRACK AND FIELD REPORT



2016/17 season was very exciting to follow. Obviously, being the Olympic year there was a lot happening.

Several of our top athletes had an Olympic team spot in their sights and rightly so.

The first one to achieve an Olympic qualifying standard was Jeff Hunt with his 2:16:09 marathon that he ran in Hamburg on 17th April. Unfortunately for him, there were other 3 athletes who ran faster times and Jeff missed out

on his second Olympics.

Steven Solomon, who made London Olympics 400m final in 2012, was nearly a certain bet to make an Olympic team. At the beginning of June he clocked 45.44 in Townsville which was only 0.04 sec off the qualifier. We were absolutely certain that he would run faster in Europe but somehow it didn't happen. He had another five sub 46 sec races but simply luck wasn't on his side; at few of these meetings the weather conditions were atrocious.

We had two RBH girls chasing 800m qualifier which stood at 2:01.50. Selma Kajan was pretty dominant during domestic season winning races in Hobart, Brisbane and Perth before coming 2nd in very tactical National Championships. Also Lora Storey, who made the switch from 400m hurdles, was improving rapidly and with her 2:02.68 time during domestic season had realistic chance to reach qualifying standard. Both girls went to US for some altitude training before continuing racing. Lora ran fantastic PB in Palo Alto (USA) on 1st May clocking 2:01.67 just 0.17 shy of the Olympic standard. Interestingly enough, Selma ran exactly same time in Montreuil (France) on 7th June.

After that Lora had a string of 2:02.xx races but the elusive qualifier just wasn't coming. Selma was running even slower with few races at 2:06-2:07 level, the reason was virus that she couldn't shake off for few weeks. The time was running out for both girls.

Finally on 30th June at race in Barcelona, Selma clocked 2:01.27 in pretty messy race, thus securing spot in the Olympic team. Unfortunately, three days before her race in Rio, she got sick again and wasn't able to perform at her best. She ran 2:05.20 and was eliminated in the first round.

Another quality athlete in pursuit of Olympic qualifier was Kate Spencer who was agonisingly close to 5000m standard (missing it only for 4.47 sec) with her tremendous race in Portland (USA) on 12th June. Her time of 15:28.47 was new club record.

Molly Blakey and Amy Harding-Delooze competed in the World Junior Championships, Molly in the 400m (7th/Heat 5 with time 55.49) and Amy in the 1500m (11th/Heat 2 with time 4:25.38). Both girls had less than ideal preparation leading to this big competition because of injuries.



At the World Cross Country Championships in Kampala (Uganda) this year, we had three athletes from our club representing Australia. Lexie Gilmour competed in Open Women (80th) event and Zac Facioni (65th) and Georgia Evans (67th) both competed in the juniors division. Emily Hopper also qualified but unfortunately had to miss due to injury.

In the World Masters Championships, Anna Fitzgerald won gold in the W35 5k and 10k events while Gary Howard won silver in the M40 800m.

At Australian Open Track and Field Championships in Sydney we end up with 2 gold medals: Steven Solomon in 400m (his 5th title) and Lora Storey in 800m. Also worth mentioning was 7th place for Edward Vining in 1500m and 8th place for Abigail Regan in 800m.

In the winter season our club came 9th for the Winter Club Trophy. In the Winter Premiership our Open Men team came 2nd behind Sydney University. U20 girls were also 2nd. Open Women's team was 3rd, same like last season.

Few of the highlights of winter season include 11th consecutive win for our Open Men team at State Road Relays, Open Men team victories at Novice and State Long cross country championships.

Many thanks to our club coaches especially Ken Green and Gary Howard who helped to put together our relay teams.




